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# Block Courses

## Children in Crisis / Module 3: Hands that Heal; Sexually Exploited and Trafficked Children

*Date: Monday 19<sup>th</sup> – Friday 23<sup>rd</sup> March*

*Trainer: Becky Bee, WEC NZ Director*

*(5 credits • NZQF level 6)*

NZ\$ 387 including lunch & morning tea

This hands-on, practical course deals with the issues faced by children who have been sexually exploited or trafficked into the sex industry. We study holistic intervention strategies to address the children's needs and to bring healing and hope. We also look at ways of caring for the caregivers, who frequently suffer from stress, burnout and compassion fatigue.

## Romans

A study of Paul's letter to the Romans including a structural and contextual overview, an exegetical treatment of selected passages, and a study of major theological themes and emphases. This one week block course is taught with a special emphasis on God's plan of salvation for the nations.

## Huia Come Home

A one week introductory examination of the interaction and struggles between the Christian and Maori worlds. This course will revisit the early missionaries, the transformative message of the gospel and the cultural missteps of the Treaty of Waitangi and offers the chance to reconnect with the unique story by looking through the indigenous Maori lens.

## Church Planting Across Cultures

*Date: Tuesday 13<sup>th</sup> – Wednesday 26<sup>th</sup> September*

*Trainer: Dr Ron Barber, PhD. TEAM*

*(10 credits • NZQF level 6)*

This two week course overviews the process of starting churches and their consequent maturation and growth. Particular focus is placed on the challenges of planting indigenous churches in a cross cultural context. The course provides a biblical basis for church planting and develops a biblical ecclesiology. The course will address significant theoretical issues before introducing models and strategies needed for indigenous church planting .
