Information

- 1. Housing is allocated prior to arrival at college. Needs of students and families is taken into consideration during the process of allocation. The College Residential Host is available to discuss any needs or concerns that students may have regarding accommodation.
- 2. Towards the end of each semester the Residential Host will inform all students of any accommodation moves that may need to take place to accommodate in-coming students.
- 3. Any health and safety concerns in the flats or campus must be reported to the Site Manager.
- Any complaints regarding college accommodation should be lodged with the Residential Host who will seek to address the complaint and will log them in the college Accommodation Complaints Log.
- 5. College staff members have the right to enter a student's room without permission for health and safety reasons only.

Expectations

- 1. Our desire is that all students have a good experience of living on Campus. Please refer to the requirements outlined in the College handbook, Community life, section 44.
- We acknowledge that cross-cultural living can cause misunderstandings to arise. Students are asked to contact their Care Group Staff Leader or the Pastoral Care Dean for help and support with conflict resolution if needed.
- 3. Accommodation is equipped with cooking facilities and kitchen equipment. International students have all linen/towels provided as described in the acceptance information. All students must replace any kitchen equipment and linen/towels damaged or lost.
- 4. We have a policy of no smoking of any substances on site. No alcohol is permitted in any public area. Drunkenness is prohibited. Please refer to the college handbook, community life, section 53.
- 5. Each flat has a schedule for regular cleaning. Students must follow the cleaning schedule and comply with flat inspections each semester. Cleaning products are provided.
- 6. For information on bonds, fees refund policy, penalties, complaints and disciplinary processes please refer to the finance section of the College Handbook.
